Please Note: There are 2 types of positions.

1. Employee basis for individuals who will only be caring for pets through Furry Fellas Pet Service
2. Independent Contractor Basis for those who currently have their own pet sitting businesses or other animal related business or are pet professionals such as dog groomers, dog trainers, vet techs or animal shelter owners/managers.

Compensation:

(Paid per visit, can usually fit in 2-3 visits per hour depending on visit length!)

Employee: \$10 per 40-45min visit, \$9 per 20-30min visit, \$8 per 10-15min visit

Independent Contractor: \$12 per 45min visit, \$11 per 20-30min visit, \$10 per 15min visit

Part Time Dog Walkers –

Afternoon availability between 10am-3pm on Mondays thru Fridays.

Please Note; We set our routes up so sitters/walkers are not traveling more than 10-15mins between a house. The average visit length requested is 20mins or 30mins so we can normally fit in more than 1 visit during an hour.
